ASTORIA LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD

MEMBERS: 5

FUNCTION: The Astoria Library Advisory Board meets monthly with the Library Director,

represents the public's interests, and advises the Council on general library policy. Recommendations may be reviewed by the Council and generally made operational upon Council approval. The Board engages in long-term, strategic planning and advocates for library services within the community. The Library Advisory Board advises the City Council on significant projects,

such as long term planning for a new or remodeled library.

TERM: 4 years (there is a 2 term limit)

DATES: 4th Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Library Flag Room, 450 10th

Street.

ASTORIA PUBLIC LIBRARY REVITALIZATION COMMITTEE

MEMBERS: 12, up to 2 of which are appointed from the Astoria Library Advisory Board

FUNCTION: The APL Revitalization Committee meets with the Project Manager

(currently the Library Director) as needed, throughout the life of the project, to implement a new or remodeled library building. The Committee, either directly or through a Community Engagement subcommittee, develops and implements a comprehensive communications plan. The communications plan includes education of the community about the project, updates funding milestones that have been achieved, and presents other information

as needed that documents the progress of the project.

TERM: Indefinite

DATES: The Committee meets as needed, generally on the first Tuesday,

Wednesday or Thursday of the month on a rotating schedule, Library Flag

Room, 450 10th Street.

BUDGET COMMITTEE

MEMBERS: 5 in addition to 5 City Council members

FUNCTION: This committee's job is to review the budget submitted by the staff and to

set spending policy and the tax rate for the coming year. A knowledge of general finance is helpful and an understanding of the business operated by the City. These are not absolutely necessary since the City is a huge business and it does take considerable time to understand all of the city

operations.

TERM: 3 years

DATES: The Committee generally meets during the month of April in the Astoria City

Hall Council Chambers, 1095 Duane Street.

DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE

MEMBERS: 5

FUNCTION: This committee's job is to evaluate the design of proposed projects based

on established design review guidelines in Overlay Areas. The committee consists of a builder, a design professional (architect, landscape architect, building designer, or artist), a businessperson, a citizen representative, and a Historic Landmarks Commission representative. This committee's

decisions can be appealed to the City Council.

TERM: 4 years

DATES: 1st Thursday each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Astoria City Hall Council

Chambers, 1095 Duane Street.

HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION

MEMBERS: 7

FUNCTION: It is the Commission's job to promote and encourage the preservation,

restoration, rehabilitation, and adaptive use of buildings, structures, appurtenances, objects, sites, and districts that are indicative of Astoria's historical heritage; to carry out certain provisions of the Land Conservation and Development Commission; and to review historic design review permits. This commission's decisions can be appealed to the City Council.

TERM: 4 years

DATES: 3rd Tuesday each month at 5:15 p.m. in the Astoria City Hall Council

Chambers, 1095 Duane Street.

HOSPITAL AUTHORITY BOARD

MEMBERS: 5

FUNCTION: The committee meets as needed. The Authority was created when the new

Columbia Memorial Hospital was built and they cooperate with the Hospital

Board and staff.

TERM: 3 years (there is a 2 term limit)

DATES: When necessary at the Columbia Memorial Hospital Health & Wellness

Pavilion, 2265 Exchange Street.

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

MEMBERS: 10

FUNCTION: The Parks and Recreation Board is made up of nine (9) members who shall

reside within the City of Astoria; one (1) member may reside outside of Astoria at any given time. Each of the ten (10) regular board members shall serve a term of three years with a term of at least one regular board member expiring annually. The Board advises the Parks and Recreation Director concerning the management, care and control of public parks and recreation facilities

owned by the City of Astoria and Ocean View Cemetery.

TERM: 4 years

DATES: 4th Monday of each month at 6:45 a.m. at the Astoria Recreation Center

(ARC), 1555 W. Marine Drive.

PLANNING COMMISSION

MEMBERS: 7

FUNCTION: The Planning Commission carries certain authorities involving conditional

uses, variances, amendments, and other land use permits; however, their decisions can be appealed to the City Council. It is their duty to maintain the Comprehensive Plan of the City which is required under the Land

Conservation and Development Commission rules and regulations.

TERM: 4 years

DATES: 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m., in the Astoria City Hall Council

Chambers, 1095 Duane Street. Work sessions are needed from time to

time.

3R COMMITTEE

MEMBERS: 8

FUNCTION: The committee meets as needed. This committee's primary function is to

suggest methods for improving or expanding the solid waste reduction

efforts by the City which includes recycling.

TERM: One year

DATES: When necessary at Astoria City Hall, 1095 Duane Street.
