The City of Astoria is conducting a study to expand the Astor West Urban Renewal Area (AWURA). Please join us to share your input about the revitalization of Bond Street, new or renovated housing opportunities, and traffic calming ideas for Bond Street.

The potential expansion includes a section of Bond Street that would fund the reopening of the street to two way traffic. In addition, the City could potentially assist residential property owners with making improvements to revitalize the neighborhood and preserve affordable housing.

Why should you attend this open house?

- Learn more about the slide area above Bond Street and the types of street improvements that are planned
- Come meet your neighbors and share your ideas for how to improve the Uniontown Neighborhood.

- Ask city staff about other potential projects in the Uniontown area such as the new “Extreme Makeover” Storefront Improvement Program for W Marine Drive businesses.

Please note the Astoria Planning Commission will also hear a presentation from city staff on this project and consider the URA Plan & Report that is required by ORS 457.

The APC meeting will begin at 630 pm in Council Chambers.

If the APC recommends approval, the City Council will hold a hearing and 1st Reading of an Ordinance to approve the boundary expansion.
