## ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT & CLEANUP HERITAGE SQUARE PROJECT

Work crews will be doing cleanup work starting on Monday January 4<sup>th</sup> on behalf of the City of Astoria. Work is expected to take two weeks. Motorists should expect a one-lane closure along the south side of Duane Street between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets during daytime hours where the work is taking place. Parking on both sides of Duane in the vicinity of the project, will also be temporarily closed. Traffic control will be set up to direct traffic.

The work is being funded through an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfield Grant that the City received in August 2012.
