Complete applications must be received by the 13th of the month to be considered for the following month's HLC agenda (allowing for public noticing period). Your attendance at the HLC meeting is recommended. A pre-application meeting with the Planner may be required prior to the acceptance of the application. Application submittal gives permission to City Staff to access the property for necessary site visits, i.e., posting of public hearing notices; photos; etc.
