

ORDINANCE NO. 0 55-19

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER ERIC HAUKE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STREET NAMES IN THE CITY OF ASTORIA.

THE CITY OF ASTORIA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established an official system of street names for the City of Astoria, Oregon, as shown on the map entitled "Map and plat of the City of Astoria", dated May 16th, 1955, copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION "2. Names of streets in the City of Astoria shall remain as shown on said map and plat unless officially changed by specific Ordinance passed subsequent to this date.

SECTION 3. No new streets shall be accepted by the City nor municipal improvements made therein until such streets have been named; if they are extensions of existing streets, the existing names shall be continued, and if not extensions, names recorded shall not duplicate or closely approximate street names already assigned.
